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The Tenant Site is the public website where people find a home and start applying. It is the front door to LeaseOps for anyone who does not yet have an account.

Who uses it

Prospective applicants — the public. They arrive from a property link, a search, or an owner's advert. They do not need to log in to browse.

What they can do

- **View a property listing.** Each listing shows the property's photos, amenities, units, and neighborhood. This content comes from the owner. See how owners build it in [Adding a Property](#).
- **Start an application.** The listing's call-to-action opens the pre-qualification questionnaire for that property.

How it hands off

When someone starts an application, they move into the **Renter Portal** to finish. From there they pre-qualify, apply, and track progress.

- [Marketplace](#) — the same properties, inside the portal.
- [The Questionnaire](#) — the pre-qualification step.

So the Tenant Site brings people in, and the Renter Portal carries them through.
